THE NEW VDA 19.1 STANDARD APPLIES FROM FEBRUARY 2026 — *new requirements for the analysis and assessment of contamination, including electromobility and new technologies.*

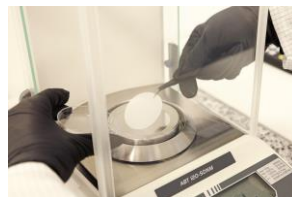
The requirements for Technical Cleanliness and environmental cleanliness are defined by the ISO 16232, ISO 13485 and ISO 14644 standards, together with VDA 19.1 and VDA 19.2. The course familiarizes participants with contamination testing and evaluation according to the new rules of the newly issued VDA 19.1 standard.

VDA Volume 19.1 “Inspection of Technical Cleanliness – Particulate Contamination of Functionally Relevant Automotive Components” covers in detail the methods and procedures used to characterize the cleanliness status of products for quality purposes in the automotive industry, and has been extended with a set of new extraction and analysis methods.

The course provides an expert explanation of the newly issued VDA 19.1 standard, including the supplementary comment procedure for the official release of the standard.

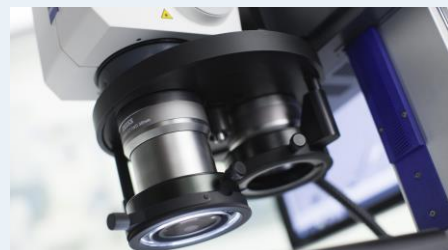
The course also includes an explanation of the specifications for Technical Cleanliness testing related to the newly issued VDA 19.1 standard.
